



Blues Point Apartment

This waterfront apartment has panoramic views of the Sydney Harbour Bridge, Opera House and Luna Park and outdoor balconies on which to sit back and feel the serenity. The deep, rich palette of charcoal greys and white and deep wooden hues in the interior evokes a sense of stillness, giving a calm and mindful ambience. In the living room, the abstract art, jewel velvet cushions and modern furnishings all add to a relaxed and free-spirited vibe. The delicate balance of the red velvet upholstery fabric on the armchairs and ottomans plays with texture to create a restful space to chill out and relax in. The huge windows accept natural light that plays over the dark silhouettes in the room and highlight a much lighter grey couch at the heart of the grey living room. The black and gold marble TV wall is balanced out by a black and gold marble kitchen island on the other side of the room. The kitchen is a dark and dramatic charcoal colour brightened only by strips of LED lighting. The master retreat has its own private balcony, walk-in robe and seating area.
