A sideshow is an extra, secondary production associated with a circus, carnival, fair, or other such attraction. A freak show, also known as a modern day sideshow , is an exhibition of biological rarities, referred to in popular culture as "freaks of nature". Typical features would be physically unusual humans, such as those uncommonly large or small, those with extraordinary conditions, and others with performances expected to be shocking to viewers. Heavily tattooed or pierced people, attention-getting physical performers such as fire-eating and swordswallowing acts.




What was a very basic and small industrial rehearsal studio was converted into functional offices for 'Split Payments' Headquarters. Zoe was responsible for design concept as well as selections. She Project Managing the trade team and was hands on for install. Structural changes were made to improve layout including replacing steel beams. The upstairs mezzanine was extended to create a meeting room. Industrial styled stairs replace an inadequate loft ladder and chic mezzanine railings were constructed to meet building regulations. The style is Industrial yet feminine. Open adjoining areas have been created with ventilation and storage considered with final touches including safety, exit lights smoke alarms etc. Outcome delivered on time!

Lots of natural fibres have been used combined with Moroccan patterns. I also added charming accessories and art with an antique accent.

The walls have been painted with highlight trims. I have drawn in a brick wall and new fireplace. The couch and shions have been reupholstered and chesterfield armchair added. A modern chandelier now hangs, a new table installed and there are plenty of accessories. The Afghan hound satisfactorily places the sheepskins I tried to include that didn't quite work. vanishing point was used to achieve the one point perspective. Finally finished this room resulted in a pleasant surprise.






Rooftop Floor Plan
